

Catch registration GoFish

Since 1 January 2021, it is only possible to export fish from Norway if you are staying at a registered tourist fishing facility. All accommodations at Hitra Turistservice belong to the registered tourist fishing facilities. The quota for the export of fish and fish products is 18 kg. Freshwater fish such as salmon and trout are not within the 18 kg export quota.

As a fishing guest you must:

- Register catch daily
- The catches must be registered in numbers
- Fish that have been released must also be registered.
- Trips without a catch must also be registered
- Catches must be registered per boat

Set up GoFish as shortcut/"app"

1. **For Android:** Go to www.gofish.no
2. Select „Log In“ in the upper right corner.
3. Select „Fisherman“
4. You have now reached the website that you will save as an app icon on your phone.
5. Tap the three dots in the upper right corner, next to the address field of the website.
6. In the list that appears, select "Add to homepage"
7. You have now created a shortcut to GoFish.

1. **For iPhone(Safari):** Go to www.gofish.no
2. Select „Log In“ in the upper right corner.
3. Select „Fisherman“
4. You have now reached the website that you will save as an app icon on your phone.
5. Touch the arrow at the bottom center of the screen
6. In the list that appears, select "Add to home screen"
7. You have now created a shortcut to GoFish.

Catch Registration:

1. Log in with your pin or phone number.
2. Select „Catch registration“ on the left side
3. Enter the numbers of the caught species in the "Kept" field and the released species in the "Released" field.
4. After you have entered all species, select "Register Catch" in the upper right corner. If you go out without a catch, select "Zero catch" in the upper right corner.

Your daily catch is now registered.

Fish to register:

*Cod
Saithe / Coalfish
Halibut
Wolffish
Redfish*

The documentation of your catch registration will be provided to you by the landlord before your departure. This is a certificate that confirms to you as a guest that you can export a quota of 18 kg from Norway.
